

#### **ENGAGEMENT INITIATIVES:**

Undergraduate Advisors: The Undergraduate Chapter Advisors serve as the joining link between the University, undergraduate chapters, Province, Alumni and Grand Chapter. The Province needs more accountability on how Advisors are working with Undergraduates. What are the measures, have a mid-semester and end semester performance assessment using an electronic form?

- How can we better support and train Advisors for the following: Contact with the School?
   How often are they meeting with Undergrads?
- Are Advisors following the U/G member's GPAs? How can Advisors help U/Gs improve their grades? What resources are available?
- Are Advisors helping with professional growth? Are Advisors helping with community service? Are advisors helping with budgeting and running a meeting? There may be other items that Advisors can assist with. We just need to ensure they are in communication.





#### **ENGAGEMENT INITIATIVE (Cont.):**

**Undergraduate Campus Involvement:** Undergraduate Chapters and their membership must add value to their campus.

- Are your members tapped for leadership opportunities?
- Are your members asked to sit on panels for potential students or parents?
- Are other student organizations looking for opportunities to partner with your chapter?
- Does your social media have many followers and positive interactions?
- Do you have positive relationships with university or college administrators?

Senior Kappa Affairs: History exchange from Brother to Brother

- Senior Kappa Week is an excellent opportunity to embody our theme and foster mentoring and information sharing with Senior Kappas.
